

If this information is not uploaded, your student will not be eligible to sell in the sale. The 1-2 minute video should include your name, chapter, and a brief statement selling your animal to potential Buyers for Auction. All pictures and Videos are to be done in full official FFA uniform!

Scroll down and click "Information is correct, continue"
Click "View/Print Transactions made by this exhibitor"
You should be able to see your entry from this year that you
already made
