If you are a recipient of this scholarship, the following criteria must be met in order to receive the scholarship money:

1. After enrollment in a college, university, community college or vocational/technical institution **the Student must submit a copy of their course schedule after the add/drop date showing enrollment. This is an Official Document with school name, student name, and proof of enrollment. A copy of their course schedule must be submitted to the Galt Ag Boosters Treasurer.** Remittance details will be included in award letter.
2. All scholarship funds must be claimed by the end of the second school year after the student's graduation from high school: If not, the scholarship award will be revoked and funds will be returned to the Galt Ag Boosters general scholarship fund.

Program Completer (5 points, this is an all or nothing category)

All scholarship candidates who are Galt High School/Liberty Ranch High School Agriculture Program completers will receive 5 points.

Points are given for your total G.P.A. as follows:

3.75 – 4.0 = 5 points 3.5 – 3.75 = 4 points 3.5 – 3.25 = 3 points 3.25 – 3.0 = 2 points

State FFA Degree (5 points, this is an all or nothing category)

If you hold the State FFA Degree, you will receive 5 points.

FFA Office (5 points, this is an all or nothing category)

If you were elected for an FFA office at any level, including Greenhand, Chapter, Section, Region or State, you will receive 5 points.

Freshman year activities (0-15 points)

These activities might include Opening/ Closing, Creed, BIG team, Greenhand Office, Novice Agriculture science Fair, Committee members, Judging Teams, CDE Teams, Fairs and/or Shows, FFA Leadership Development activities, Star Greenhand.

Sophomore year activities (0-15 points)

These activities might include Parliamentary Procedure Team, Judging Teams, CDE Teams, Public Speaking, Job Interview, Committee participation, Fairs and/or Shows, FFA Leadership Development activities, Proficiency Awards, Sectional Office, Star Chapter Farmer.

Junior year activities (0-15 points)

These activities might include Parliamentary Procedure Team, Judging Teams, Public Speaking, Job Interview, Agri-science Fair, Committee participation, Fairs and/or shows, FFA Leadership Development activities, Chapter Office, Regional Office, Star Chapter Farmer, State FFA Degree, Proficiency Awards.

Senior year activities (0-15 points)

These activities might include Parliamentary Procedure Team, Judging Teams, CDE Teams, Public Speaking, Job Interview, Committee participation, Fairs and/or Shows, Leadership Development activities, Chapter Office, Regional Office, Star Chapter Farmer, State FFA Degree, Proficiency Awards.

School & Community Involvement (0-5 points)
